SMOKE FREE POLICY

RATIONALE:

- St. Michael's Church School is a Christian School in the Anglican tradition reflecting the intentions of the St. Michael's Church School Statute.
- Smoking is a danger to health. Pupils should not be exposed to second hand smoking or be led to believe smoking is acceptable.

PURPOSES:

- To ensure staff act as positive role models.
- Pupils are not exposed to second hand smoking

GUIDELINES:

- No smoking is allowed in the school environs at any time when pupils are present.
- No room or outdoor space away from pupil should be provided where smokers, either staff or visitors, might smoke out of sight of pupils.
- When the hall is let for non-school activities, eg a funeral or wedding, then smoking inside the fence line will be actively discouraged.

CONCLUSION:

Smoking will not occur in the environs of St Michael's Church School.
